The Battleship NORTH CAROLINA is open every day of the year, including all holidays, as the ship is a memorial.

- Summer Hours (Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day) 8:00am - 8:00pm, EXCEPT Independence Day when the ship closes at 6:00pm to prepare for fireworks.
- Winter Hours (After Labor Day weekend through Thursday prior to Memorial Day weekend) 8:00am - 5:00pm.

\* PLEASE NOTE: ticket sales end one hour before closing.

Visitors should allow two hours to tour the Battleship. The tour route is well marked and you can tour at your own pace.

Begin the tour in the Visitor's Center with the orientation exhibit *Through Their Eyes: The Battleship Crew Remembers WWII*.

The self-guided tour includes portions of nine decks where you can enter gun turrets, inspect the bridge, view the crew's quarters, sick bay, an engine room and much more. Discover how the ship was a floating city with places to sleep, eat, see movies, mail letters and get a hair cut. On the ship's main deck see one of the remaining Vought Kingfisher float planes. In the ship's Wardroom, the Roll of Honor memorializes the names of the 10,000 North Carolinians who gave their lives during World War II.

Conclude your tour in the Ship's Store and the Pepsi Canteen or enjoy a stroll through Battleship Park overlooking historic downtown Wilmington.
