The Battleship NORTH CAROLINA is open every day of the year, including all holidays, as the ship is a memorial.

- Summer Hours (Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day) 8:00am - 8:00pm, EXCEPT Independence Day when the ship closes at 6:00pm to prepare for fireworks.
- Winter Hours (After Labor Day weekend through Thursday prior to Memorial Day weekend) 8:00am - 5:00pm

Groups should allow two hours to tour the Battleship since portions of nine decks are open to the public. Once onboard, your group can enter gun turrets, inspect the bridge, view crew's quarters, sick bay, an engine room and much more. On the ship's deck they have the opportunity to see a Vought Kingfisher float plane and the Roll of Honor Room which memorializes the names of nearly 10,000 North Carolinians who gave their lives during World War II. Informational plaques and button-operated speakers describe key areas throughout the ship.

All tours are self-guided.

The Battleship offers tiered pricing. Professional Tour Operators receive a 25% discount for Groups of 20 or more when admission fees are paid by a single source (cash, check, Visa or Mastercard). Those discounted group rates are as follows:
