Wilmington, NC – November 19, 2019 – Because of tidal flooding, Battleship NORTH CAROLINA will close this afternoon. Today's last ticket will be sold at noon. Rising waters are expected to affect access to the Battleship starting about 1 p.m.

High tidal flooding is expected to continue over the next week and may result in further limited hours. Updates will be sent by email and posted on social media and BattleshipNC.com.
